“DARWIN’S DILEMMA:

THE MYSTERY OF THE CAMBRIAN FOSSIL RECORD”

Darwin’s Dilemma, as facilitated by Dr. Ken Dean, explores one of the great mysteries in the history of life: the geologically-sudden appearance of dozens of major complex animal types in the fossil record without any trace of the gradual transitional steps Charles Darwin had predicted. Frequently described as “the Cambrian Explosion,” the development of these new animal types required a massive increase in genetic information. The big question that the Cambrian Explosion poses is where does all that new information come from?

“THE LOGICAL IMPLICATIONS OF YOUR CREATION ACCOUNT CHOICES”



If Darwinian evolution is true, then what would that entail for many of humanity’s most cherished beliefs? Mr. Dave Glover will discuss the ramifications evolutionary theory has on one such cherished belief: the belief that we are under an obligation to abide by certain commonly held moral duties. He will argue that anyone believing in both Darwinian evolution and any form of moral obligation possesses an inconsistent belief set.

“A PROPER READING OF GENESIS 1:1-2:3”

Is a simple, straight forward reading of Genesis 1:1-2:3 conclusive or is this an area which God left open for science to reconcile? Dr. Boyd will discuss whether or not this passage in Genesis is to be taken figuratively or literally. He will specifically address the word “day” as used in the Bible and he will explain how one’s interpretation of Genesis 1:1-2:3 affects one’s understanding of other texts in Scripture.
